

Now that you have covered your efforts in prayer:

- 1. Bring your invited guest to the Newcomer Station at Entrance B (the Chapel Entrance) or use that entrance as your meeting spot. Introduce your guest to the Newcomer Team Volunteers. They are fully equipped to help you. Let them.

- 3. Make sure your guest completes a Guest Welcome Card (the blue card found in the pew backs and scattered elsewhere around the campus.) They then will be automatically included in Newcomer-centric information sharing. Also, introduce them to a Pastor or two.
- 4. Be mindful of your language. More and more, our newcomers are new to anything having to do with church or faith. Even words and phrases like worship, Sunday School, and "join the church" are foreign in many cases.
- 5. Remember the hero of the story. It is not you. It is not JCBC. It's not even Jesus at this point. The hero of the story is the person standing right in front of you. That's the person Jesus wants you to love. That's the person Jesus wants to transform from the inside out.
- 6. Remember that you are not a salesperson and remember that the person you are inviting into the life of this church is not your child, your protégé, your project, or your target. The person you are loving into the life of this church is your neighbor. Love them well.
