# At Home Lesson The Bible (2 Timothy 3:16-17)

Gather your family together. Start off in prayer. Pray for each other, the church, the leaders around the world, and people who you know are in need. Ask God to teach your family something during this time together. Tell the Bible story and discuss. Stay open and make sure kids are invited to participate however, they are comfortable.

# **BIBLE STORY**

Here is the passage from the NIrV:

"God has breathed life into all Scripture. It is useful for teaching us what is true. It is useful for correcting our mistakes. It is useful for making our lives whole again. It is useful for training us to do what is right. By using Scripture, the servant of God can be completely prepared to do every good thing."

# LEARN, CONNECT, AND DISCUSS

Talk about the Bible with your kids. Teach them the following Bible facts and connect them to how the Bible can help your family in your everyday life.

- There are 66 books of the Bible.
  - o 39 Old Testament
  - 27 New Testament
- The first book is Genesis.
- The last book is Revelation.
- The Old Testament is full of stories, history, laws, wisdom, and prophecy passed down and written before Jesus' birth. The Old Testament teaches us all about God's people, the Israelites, and how God was faithful to them through history.
- The New Testament starts with Jesus' birth. The first 4 books are called the Gospels, they teach about Jesus' life and ministry. The other books are about the early church and letters to new Christians, teaching us how to live for Christ.

Connection & Review Questions:

- Reread 2 Timothy 3:16-17
  - What do you think it means that God "breathed life into all Scripture?"
  - Why do you think it's important for us to read and study the Bible?
  - What does this passage say the servants of God need to "be prepared to do every good thing?"
- Do you have a favorite Bible verse or book of the Bible? If so, what is it and why is it your favorite?
  - Parents, you answer these too. Share what scripture means to you and why it's important to you.
- Why is the Bible true?
  - Because it teaches us true things about God, people, and how we can live for Jesus.
- How many books are in the Bible? The Old Testament? The New Testament?
- How many verses do you think you've memorized?
  - Why is it important to memorize scripture?
- Do you know all of the books of the Bible?
  - It's important for us to memorize the Books of the Bible and memorize different verses so that we can use the Bible in our life every day! When we know the Bible, then we know about God! We can use the knowledge and wisdom of Scripture to help keep us out of sin, defend our minds against fear and negativity, and help us make good decisions!
  - Let's practice the Books of the Bible!

# **BOOKS OF THE BIBLE ACTIVITIES**

- Flash Cards: print the flash cards below and cut them out. Spread them out on the table and help your kids put them in order!
  - You can also flip the cards upside down and out of order. Play it like a memory card game where you flip one card over and then try to find the book that comes before and after.
  - Once you use the flash cards for the game, keep them together in order. You can punch a hole in the corner and string them together with twine or a metal ring. Let your kids flip through them to review!'
- Bingo: print the BIBLE BINGO cards below and play Bingo with your family!
- Hopscotch: Print off the books of the Old Testament and New Testament each book on its own paper. Set the books out like hopscotch. Play hopscotch where you say the book of the bible as you step/jump on each one!

- Jenga: Write the books of the Bible on Jenga pieces. Play Jenga: as you take off a block, place the blocks out on the floor/table in order of the Books written on the blocks.
- Legos: Write the books of the Bible on Lego blocks. Spread out the blocks around your workspace. Tell your kids to stack the Legos in order of the Books of the Bible written on the blocks.
  - Make this one extra fun by making it a competition:
    - Time your kids/each member of the family to see who can stack them in order fasted.
    - Time your kid(s) and have them stack the Legos multiple times to set a "personal record" and try to beat that time!


# WORSHIP SONGS




# **CLOSE IN PRAYER**

Pray and thank God for sending us the Bible. Commit to studying the Bible individually and as a family. Ask God to teach you and shape you through Scripture!
















































































Memorization

Mix up the set and give the class a possible. Divide the class into teams if you have lots of students and give each team a set.




## Concentration Lay the cards out on a table in order. Point to each in turn and have the students say the card. Help them learn to
