



Well Child & Volunteer Policy

Parents: For the protection of all our children and adults, please adhere to these guidelines when determining if you should bring your child or yourself to Johns Creek Baptist Church.

A well child has:

- No fever over 99.6° currently or for the last 24 hours.
- No vomiting or diarrhea currently or for the last 24 hours.
- No green, runny nose from onset through one week.
- No childhood diseases such as chickenpox, mumps, measles, rubella, pertussis, or scarlet fever.
- No cough, whether mild or severe.
- No respiratory distress or shortness of breath.
- No unexplained rashes.
- No eye infections.
- No skin infections (impetigo, boils or ringworm).

If a child currently has any of the above symptoms, the teacher will not be able to accept him/her into preschool or elementary care. If a child *develops* any of the above symptoms while in our care, we will ask you to come get him/her. We cannot administer medication of any kind. If an adult has any of the above symptoms, please stay home and follow recommended preventative measures until you are well. Your cooperation will protect the health of all our children and adults.
